We currently have a request that you would like to be part of the West Kentucky College Academy, through your high school. At this time, either WKCTC does not have your ACT or COMPASS scores **or** the scores have not been met. To be enrolled in any online course or on-campus WKCTC course, you must have scored an 18 in English **and** a 20 in Reading on the ACT. If you plan to take MAT 150 – College Algebra, you must have a 22 in Math on the ACT. All courses require a reading score. Please refer to the Reading Placement Chart on our website.

As an alternate assessment, you can take the COMPASS placement test, which is a computerized adaptive testing system that helps place students in appropriate courses. WKCTC offers the COMPASS in the Anderson Technical Building, Monday – Friday from 8:00am until 4:30pm to take the COMPASS test. The score that you will need to obtain in English/Writing is a 74, an 85 in Reading, and a 50 in Algebra. The test is free the first time you come in; however, it will cost \$7 per test if you need to retest. If you need to contact the Assessment Center, please call 534-3408.
