Attendance at one conference is required to apply for the Practical Nursing Program

All conferences will be held in the Allied Health Building Room E206 at 4:00 pm.

Requirements:

- Attendance at a pre-admission conference.
- Application for admission to the college.
- Official High School transcript indicating that the applicant has or will complete an approved four year high school course of study or a passing GED official score report .
- Official transcript of post-secondary education.
- Results of ACT, NLN Pre-Admission Exam or Evolve Admission Assessment (A2) Exam.
- Proof of active status on the Medicaid Nurse Aide Registry or successful completion of an equivalent course within the past 3 years.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 grade point average.

In order to be considered for admission to the program, applicants must submit all required paperwork by October 1, 2019.
