- **The GPA is calculated using the best 10-12 graded credit hours in the approved curriculum from a regionally accredited college or a KCTCS college. Remedial or developmental coursework is not included in graded credit hours.
- Points will be awarded to students who have completed BIO 137 and 139, Anatomy and Physiology I and II and/or MAT 150 College Algebra with at least a grade of B. Six points will be awarded for an A; three points will be awarded for a B. Students may earn a maximum of eighteen (18) points in this area.
- Points will be awarded for ACT scores per the table above.
- Two points will be awarded to those applicants who are Kentucky residents.
- Up to 4 total points will be awarded for the following:
 1. Documented employment as a Physical Therapy Aide or Technician under the supervision of a Physical Therapist
 - Less than 6 months - 1 point
 - 6 months to a year - 2 points
 - More than a year - 3 points

2. Documented employment in a related health care position with direct patient care (not in a PT clinic)

- Less than 6 months - 1 point
- 6 months or more - 2 points

Candidates with possible points for employment experience need to submit the following to the admissions coordinator **written by their employer**:

- a. Beginning and ending dates of employment
- b. Supervisor's name and title
- c. Specific list of patient care duties
- d. Brief summary of this candidate's performance in this position

All components must be present on the letter for points to be considered. The Admission Committee will review letters submitted by employers and assign points as appropriate.

3. Completion of direct patient care education such as the NAA 100 course at WKCTC or a comparable course

- NAA 100 or comparable course - 2 points

Candidates with possible points in this area need to submit their transcript and/or certification to the Admissions Coordinator for review.

- In the event of a tie in the total number points, the cumulative GPA is used to rank order to determine admission to the Physical Therapist Assistant program.
- Students admitted into the PTA program must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
