

The Doggone Poem Contest

Official Rules

1. Entries must be submitted between February 1 and March 12. Participants can enter only one poem.
2. Participants must fill out an entry form and statement of originality and staple this form to the poem. The poem and forms must be submitted to the library circulation desk or the Humanities office (Student Center, Room 138). Entries can also be mailed to Kim Russell, Humanities, WKCTC, PO BOX 7380, Paducah, KY, 42002-7380. NO IDENTIFYING INFORMATION (name, ID number, etc.) should be included on the paper(s) on which the poem is typed.
3. Poems must be typed (no handwritten work will be accepted). There is no minimum or maximum length. Poems must be related to dogs (or a particular dog).
4. Participants must be current students, faculty, or staff at WKCTC.
5. Winners of the contest will be awarded prizes at an event on April 1 at 2:00 in the Matheson Library, and winners will be encouraged to share their winning poems at the Celebration of Poetry event.
6. Winners will be selected by a panel of judges, and one winner from each category (student or faculty/staff) will win a \$100 Barnes and Noble gift card.
