The St. Nicholas Family Clinic opened on October 18, 1994 to provide free diagnostic and treatment services to working individuals and their families who do not have medical insurance or financial resources necessary to pay for private insurance and/or medical care. Qualified patients are not eligible to receive any health benefits from state or federal government. Additionally, they must have income that falls within the federal poverty guidelines.

Services are offered to residents of Ballard, Carlisle, Fulton, Hickman, Livingston, McCracken, and Marshall counties in Kentucky and Massac County in Illinois.

In 2010 alone, 2,395 patients were treated and 13,893 prescriptions were filled at no charge to qualifying individuals.
